**2** Start Your Application

Create a free MyExcelsior account so you can fill out the Excelsior College online application.

**3** Request Your Transcripts

Contact the schools you've attended and request that copies of your official transcripts be sent directly to:

**Do not send unofficial copies.** Unofficial transcripts cannot be used to evaluate or approve your desired transfer credits. You can check the status of your incoming transcripts in MyExcelsior.

**4** Review Your Credit Transfer Evaluation

You'll receive your credit evaluation within 5–10 business days. This will outline how many of your previously earned credits Excelsior will accept toward your degree, and how many credits you'll need to earn to complete your degree.

**(5)** Submit Your Enrollment Agreement

Once you've been admitted to Excelsior College, you'll need to submit your enrollment agreement and register for courses and/or exams. Your academic advisor will help map out a degree completion plan and then you're on your way!
